1. Objective

To encourage academic excellence and the pursuit of higher education within the communities of Skeetchestn & Tk'emlúps te Secwepemc.

2. Value and Duration of the Trades Bursary

- \$2500 CAD (based upon available funding)
- Each recipient may qualify each year, but only to a maximum of 4 consecutive sessions (e.g. if a recipient is taking a pre-apprenticeship program prior to studies for a trades apprenticeship, the bursary recipient may qualify for the pre-apprenticeship training, plus the consecutive year towards the trades certification, but only to a maximum of 4 consecutive sessions).
- It is acknowledged that there are different dates for the intake of applicants into trades programs. As a result, the bursaries are being administered based upon available funding and for those applicants who have successfully been accepted into an accredited trades program.

3. Type of Trades Bursary

Applicable towards full-time studies for new or previous applicants who are enrolled at an accredited trades/vocational or post-secondary institution. Program must be for a minimum of 2 years in length.

4. Requirement for Eligibility

- a. Status member of either Skeetchestn Indian Band or Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc.
- b. Academic
 - Eligible applicants must maintain a minimum grade as required by the program within which they are enrolled.
- c. Application form and supporting documents eligible applicants must provide:
 - A fully completed application form.
 - Evidence of Registration / Acceptance into program or course.
 - Returning Students are required to submit a copy of their Skilled Trades BC transcript.
 - <u>Two signed</u> reference letters with references' signature (e.g., Instructor, employer, education
 manager, etc.). These recommendations should outline your accomplishments and demonstrate your
 ability to succeed.
 - A 250-word essay which provides a description of yourself, your ability to succeed and your plans for the future. Please include any volunteer/community involvement, and/or extracurricular activities and how education will benefit you, your family, and your community (separate sheet of paper). When evaluating scholarships for eligibility, preference may be given to those students who directly contribute to their community of Skeetchestn Indian Band or Tk'emlúps te Secwepemc.
 - List of awards or recognition you may have received? List those achievements specifically related to your area of academic interest.

5. Field of Study / Program Requirements

Preference given to students enrolled in trades education programming that will lead to a Red Seal designation.

6. Eligible Institutions

Accredited Canadian and American post-secondary institution which have recognized Red Seal-granting designation, or their affiliates (e.g. universities and colleges).

7. Selection of Trade Bursary Winners

- a) Selection of winners is at the discretion of the Trades Bursary Committee (which is comprised of a representative appointed by Skeetchestn Indian Band, Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc, a representative from the Stk'emlupsemc te Secwépemc Nation, along with two (2) New Gold representatives).
- b) Evaluation criteria
 - Academic performance
 - Quality and relevance of the reference letters
 - Volunteer/community involvement and/or extracurricular activities

- c) The committee exercises no influence in the selection of the Trades Bursary recipients in the adjudication process.
- d) Final selection will be completed, and successful candidates will be notified via email.

8. Responsibilities of Trades Bursary Recipients

- Return the signed Trades Bursary Form and all other supporting documentation -PLEASE refer to the check list on last page.
- Use the Trades Bursary in the academic year for which it is awarded.
- Students requiring extra credits, related to their area of study or discipline, can contact the
 First Nations Coordinator to request an opportunity to research within the appropriate New
 Gold Department.
- By signing this document (page 5) you agree to the authorization of use of photos and stories written about/including you (the applicant) to be distributed among the Skeetchestn and Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc communities, as well as for use in New Gold media materials.

9. Payment

- New Gold, New Afton will forward 100% of the Trades Bursary directly to the recipient.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure that payment of tuition fees is made within the
 defined timeframe set by the post-secondary institution regardless of the timing of the
 scholarship payment.

10. Renewal of Trades Bursary

- The Trades Bursary may be renewed each period that the program is available for up to a total of 4 sessions
- A fully completed application MUST be submitted each year the applicant is eligible to apply.
- Trades Bursary recipients must maintain a full-time status as defined by the accredited trades/vocational or educational institution.
- Trades Bursary recipients must submit documentation showing successful completion of each session.
- Trades Bursary recipients must also submit a copy of their Skilled Trades BC Transcript reflecting the number of apprenticeship hours completed to date.
